

PAIDEIA EDUCATOR ENRICHMENT GRANTS APPLICATION FORM

DESCRIPTION

- Participation in a short-term, intensive study program in Greece which will:
 - survey the history, archeology, arts and literature with on-site learning at ancient Greek sites ranging from the Neolithic period to the Byzantine period,
 - offer opportunities to observe the topography, natural resources, industries and contemporary culture of modern Greece.
- Development of a portfolio that will be used by the applicant in their educational system, institution or classroom K-12.

PROCEDURES

1. APPLICATION PACKAGE INCLUDES:

- a. Personal Information
- b. Portfolio Proposal. A written proposal explaining how the candidate will apply the results of the study program to their classroom, educational institution or school district.
- c. Evaluation Component
- d. Statement indicating why the applicant is interested in the Educator Enrichment Program for Greek Studies
- e. Two Letters:
 - i. One letter of recommendation from educational professional
 - ii. one letter from the educational institution/ district validating employment and commitment to curriculum presentation.
- f. Applications must be postmarked no later than June 1 and sent to the Center for Hellenic Studies PAIDEIA
- g. Applicants may consult with the Program Coordinator if they have any questions.

b. EVALUATION COMPONENT

- i.** In Greece: focus group participation/ evaluation report
- ii.** In the US: assessment of the outcomes of the portfolio after it is presented to students
- iii.** By Paideia will be able to survey student participants and observe implementation of the Portfolio.

- a. Standards for development of the portfolios will be provided to candidates who receive a Hellenic Society Paideia Grant.
